

Captain Maxham is an ex-officio member and immediate past chairman of the Coast Guard Academy Alumni Association's Board of Directors.

Captain Maxham graduated from the Coast Guard Academy in 1966. Following graduation, he reported to the CGC *Duane* as a shipboard engineer. After a tour in Vietnam, he completed graduate school at MIT and returned to the Academy as an engineering instructor. He then spent fifteen years in the marine safety program. His senior assignments included: Commanding Officer, Marine Safety Center; Chief, Marine Technical and Hazardous Materials Division, CG Headquarters; and Head of the Academy's Engineering Department.

After his Coast Guard retirement in 1996, Captain Maxham spent four years in the private sector before returning to the Academy as the Alumni Association's Vice President for Development. During his tenure from 2000 until his retirement in 2011, the Association raised more than \$25 million in gifts to support the Academy and, under his direction, completed the successful Alumni Center and Leadership 44 coastal sail training vessel campaigns. During his time on the Association's Board of Directors, the Association developed and launched a \$30 million comprehensive campaign to support the Academy and the Corps of Cadets.
