- There will be signage and uniformed personnel directing visitors to several satellite parking lots located off campus. Transportation shuttles will be provided from off campus parking lots to Leamy Hall and on base golf carts, with priority seating for elderly and handicapped visitors, will be available for anyone wishing to avoid the hills and longer distance walks. Several lunch options are also available on base, so there is no need to leave campus until after the Swearing-In Ceremony and end of Day One.
- Please drive safely! Connecticut state law prohibits the use of cellular phones while driving and seatbelt use is mandatory. Obey posted speed limits and yield to all pedestrians, especially Swabs marching, in crosswalks or walking on the road. The maximum speed limit on base is 15 miles per hour.
